STEP 1 - ORDER

ONLINE THROUGH THE CATALOG

Put a hold on items in the library catalog by visiting catalog.ncls.org. You will need your library card # to complete the transaction. Books do not need to be owned by CFL to be borrowed, but will take a few days to be received.

THROUGH THE NCLS APP

Download the NCLS app for your Apple or Android device and place holds on the go. (The icon for the app should be white in color and feature a compass.) You will need your library card # to complete the transaction.

NOT SURE WHAT YOU WANT TO READ? ASK FOR RA!

Readers Advisory (RA) is a free service provided by librarians at CFL that helps you figure out what to read next. Simply visit cantonfreelibrary.org and select Readers Advisory.

STEP 2 - PICK UP

WAIT FOR A CALL

CFL staff will call you when your order is complete and schedule a time for pickup. You will be asked to verify your library card number.

RING THE DOORBELL

At your scheduled pickup time ring the doorbell at the front entrance to the library. A staff member will greet you and ask your name.

RETRIEVE YOUR MATERIALS

All materials will be handed to you directly by library staff.

IMPORTANT

MASKS ARE REQUIRED

Please wear a mask when arriving to pick up materials. Library staff will be doing the same.

6 FOOT DISTANCE

Please maintain a minimum of 6 feet from others when retrieving materials.

ACCOMMODATIONS

If you need additional assistance during pickup please call the library to make arrangements 315-386-3712.

RETURNS

Please place any returns in the library book drop. All returned items are quarantined for 24 hours.
